



Due to the nature of our beautiful island – We ask that you come prepared for the elements and the terrain. Outside of the bothy area is a wild and uninhabited island, care must be taken when exploring. The tidal changes can make various areas of the terrain slippery with seaweed and the flora can make for uneven walking so please always pay attention when moving around.

What to bring?

- Sleeping bag (pillows, sheet & blanket provided)
- Pillowcase
- Comfortable, waterproof footwear with good grip on the sole
- Waterproof & warm layers for the boat trip and walking around
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen/Hat
- Swimwear & towel/dry robe if paddling/swimming
- Waterproof swim shoes if you are paddling/swimming (some of our bays are not soft sand & can be uncomfortable underfoot)
- Washbag
- Pair of tweezers
- Personal battery charging pack
- Torch
- A good book or sketch pad for down time

Please be aware to regularly check yourself for ticks – Mostly easy to spot & brush off but if left can cause irritation & will need removed properly with a pair of tweezers.

WE ARE A FULLY OFFGRID SYSTEM – You must be mindful when using power/water.

- Do not leave lights on,
- Do not leave cables plugged if not using to charge,
- Do not leave taps running,
- Be mindful of your shower time to ensure adequate hot water for all.

All our power is generated by wind & solar – We have charging stations for mobile phones but ensure you have fully charged your device before arriving and only use our charging stations during the day when our batteries are full – WE ADVISE BRINGING FULLY CHARGED CHARGING PACKS

Phone signal on the island is intermittent & there is no Wi-Fi – We are an off-grid space and feel that the island is a place to set aside technology & enjoy your surroundings, but most networks have regular 4G signal and in emergencies all staff have phones & the island VHF radio.

We run on a private water supply, so we ask everyone to be mindful when using taps/showers as there is not an unlimited supply as the mainland.

You are welcome to bring your own alcoholic beverages & snacks - We please ask that you do not bring peanuts or peanut containing products.

We have zero drugs, drunk or disorderly behaviour policy – If you appear to behave in this manner towards yourself, staff members or other guests, you will be removed from the island and taken back to the mainland immediately if safe to do so & no refund will be issued.

In an emergency, 999 will be called and evacuation protocol is via helicopter or transport by boat if injured person is able and a trained member of staff deems safe to do so.

When on the boat, you must always listen to instructions by crew & skipper. When underway you must remain sitting for your safety. Lifejackets MUST be worn & any final decisions on swimming points/weather etc will be entirely at the skipper's sole discretion - We want you to get the most you can out of your experience with us, but your safety will come first & foremost.
